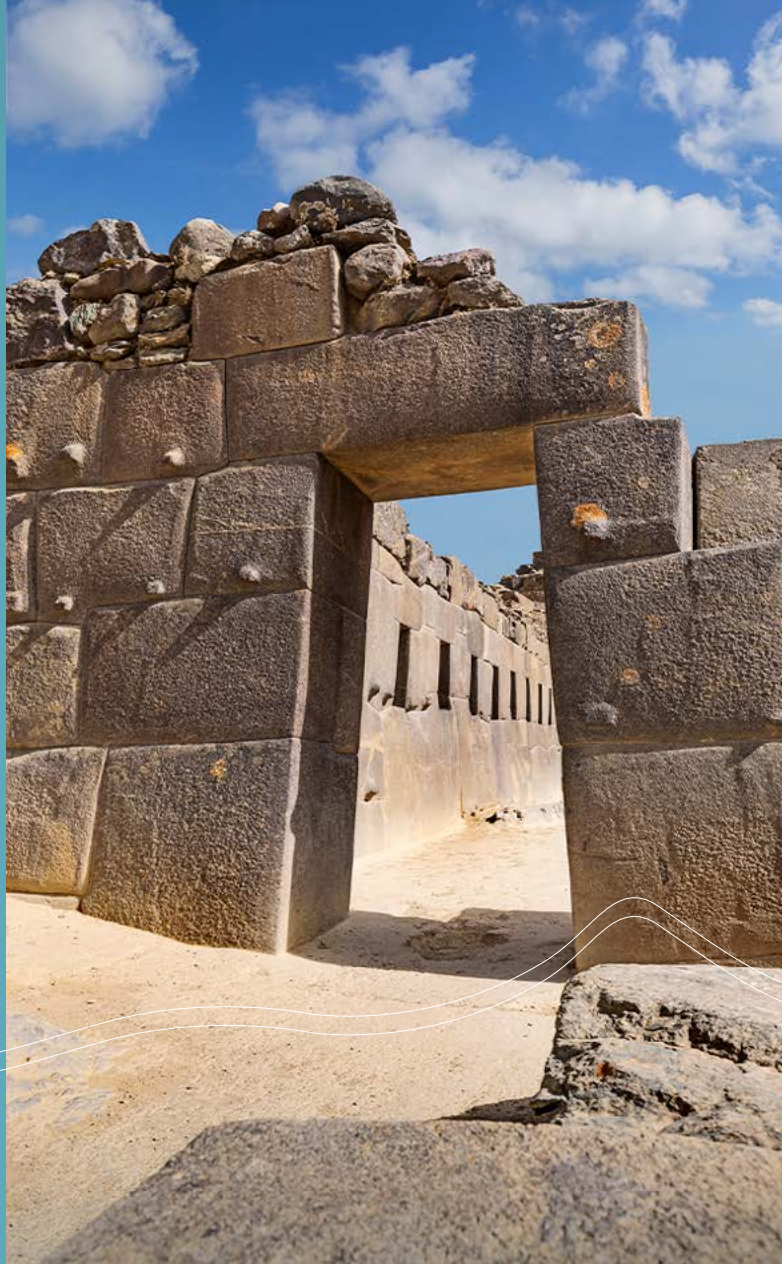

This Sacred Valley and Machu Picchu Tour 2 Days is an ideal way to explore the highlights of the Cusco region in a short time. On Day 1, you will visit the Sacred Valley, travel by train to Aguas Calientes, and stay overnight before visiting Machu Picchu early the next morning with a professional local guide.

Your journey begins with hotel pickup in Cusco and visits to an alpaca center, Taray viewpoint, Pisac archaeological site and market, Urubamba, Moray, the Maras Salt Mines, and Ollantaytambo. In the evening, you will take the Expedition train to Aguas Calientes.

On Day 2, you will take an early bus to Machu Picchu for a guided tour. Your entrance ticket is included, with Circuit 2 requested when available. If sold out, we will secure the best official alternative, usually Circuit 1 or Circuit 3.

You may also add Huayna Picchu Mountain or Machu Picchu Mountain after the guided visit, subject to availability. Only one mountain hike can be selected, and advance booking is required.

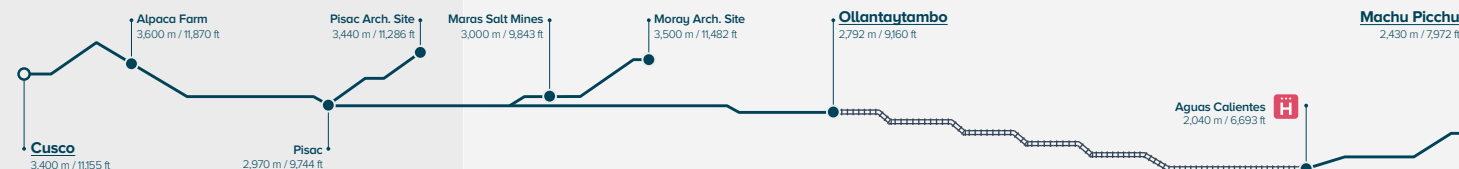

Day 1

Cusco – Alpaca Center – Taray Viewpoint – Pisac – Moray – Maras Salt Mines – Ollantaytambo – Expedition Train to Aguas Calientes

We'll pick you up from your hotel in Cusco at 7:00 a.m. approx. and drive 30 minutes to the Alpaca Farm, where you will meet llamas, alpacas, vicuñas, and guanacos. Our expert tour guides will explain the differences and importance of these South American camelids in Andean culture. Next, you will drive to Taray viewpoint to enjoy stunning views of the Sacred Valley and the Andes.

Then, we will visit the Pisac Archaeological Site, located above the town, where you can see impressive farming terraces, ancient tombs on steep slopes, temples, and aqueducts. Afterwards, you will descend to Pisac Market, where local women from nearby villages sell handmade products. This is a great place to shop and experience authentic Andean culture.

Our next stop is Urubamba, in the heart of the Sacred Valley, where you'll enjoy a delicious buffet lunch made





with fresh local ingredients, including meat and vegetables.

After lunch, we'll visit the circular terraces of Moray, believed to have been an Inca agricultural laboratory, and the Maras Salt Mines, where over 3,000 salt pools are still harvested by local families using traditional techniques.

To finish the day, we'll explore Ollantaytambo, an archaeological site with temples and terraces. We'll also visit the town, known for its narrow Inca streets, stone paving, and water channels still in use today. Dinner will be served at a local restaurant.

At 7:00 p.m., you will board the Expedition train to Aguas Calientes, where you will spend the night in a comfortable hotel.

Day 2

Explore Machu Picchu – Return to Cusco

We will wake up early for the most important day of your trip. After breakfast at the hotel, you'll board one of the first buses up to Machu Picchu. At the entrance, you must present your ticket and original passport.

Once inside, your expert guide will lead you through the best areas allowed by your assigned circuit. You'll explore terraces, temples, plazas, sacred spaces, viewpoints, and the main Inca structures while learning the history and meaning of Machu Picchu.

The guided visit usually lasts around 2 to 3 hours. We request Circuit 2 by default when available because it offers one of the most complete experiences. If Circuit 2 is sold out, we will secure the best official alternative available, usually Circuit 1 or Circuit 3.





After the guided tour, and if booked in advance, you may hike Huayna Picchu Mountain or Machu Picchu Mountain. These extra hikes are not included in the standard price, require separate tickets, and depend on official availability.

After Machu Picchu, take the bus back down to Aguas Calientes. You will have free time for lunch at a restaurant of your choice before boarding the afternoon Expedition train back to Ollantaytambo. From there, our van will take you back to your hotel in Cusco, arriving around 7:30 p.m.
