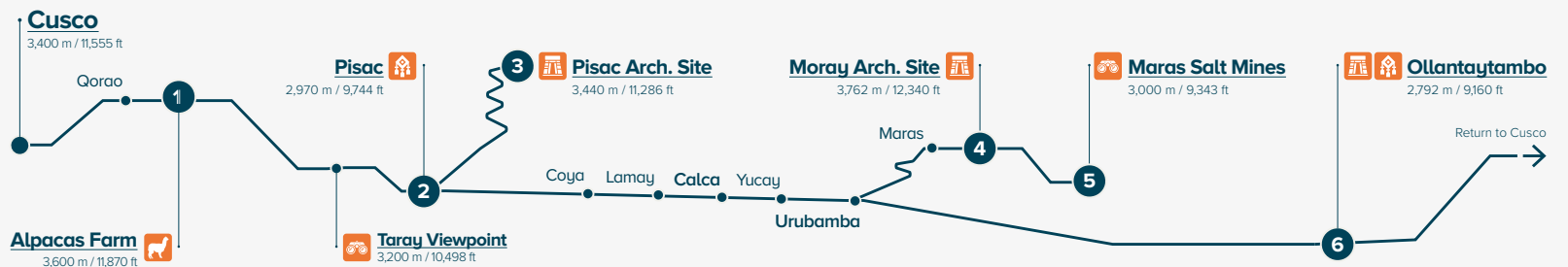

**Cusco — Alpaca Farm — Taray Viewpoint —
Pisac — Moray Archeological Site — Maras —
Ollantaytambo — Return to Cusco**

After pickup from your hotel in Cusco at 7:00 AM, travel in our comfortable vans to an alpaca farm. Here, you'll meet llamas, alpacas, vicuñas, and guanacos while learning about their cultural and economic importance in the Andes. You'll interact with and feed them, and see traditional Inca techniques used to extract, dye, and weave wool into beautiful fabrics still valued in local communities today.

Next, drive about 30 minutes to the Taray Viewpoint, where you'll enjoy a wide panoramic view of the Sacred Valley. From here, you can see the winding Urubamba River, terraced hillsides, rural villages, and snow-capped Andean peaks, making it a perfect stop for photos and a beautiful introduction to the valley.





Continue to Pisac, where you'll explore the hilltop archaeological site overlooking the valley. This impressive complex features ancestral buildings, farming terraces, residential areas, religious spaces, and South America's largest known Inca cemetery. Afterward, visit the modern town of Pisac, famous for its colorful handicraft market. You can shop for textiles, ceramics, jewelry, fresh produce, and try local favorites such as empanadas. Then, drive about one hour to Urubamba for a delicious buffet lunch prepared with fresh regional products.

After lunch, visit Moray, a fascinating Inca site known for its deep circular terraces. These terraces were likely used for agricultural experiments, allowing the Incas to test crops in different microclimates. Next, continue to the Maras Salt Mines, where more than 3,000 salt pans cover the mountainside. Used since Inca times and still active today, they are maintained by local families through generations.

Our final destination is Ollantaytambo, where you'll explore its remarkable Inca fortress. Built in the 15th century, this site served as a military, religious, and agricultural center. Its massive terraces, precise stonework, and valley views

make it one of the Sacred Valley's most important places. Ollantaytambo is also a charming living Inca town with narrow cobblestone streets, traditional architecture, gardens, local shops, and cafés, giving you time to enjoy its history, culture, and atmosphere before returning.

Finally, we'll return to Cusco and plan to drop you off at your hotel around 6:00 PM.

This full-day Sacred Valley tour is a wonderful way to experience the history, culture, landscapes, markets, and living traditions of the Andes in one unforgettable day. It brings together wildlife, archaeology, local food, traditional villages, and unforgettable views. Book now!
